“Clinical Medicine Plus” Scholarship

Call for Submissions 2020

Once again, the Prof Dr Max Cloëtta Foundation has announced the "**Clinical Medicine Plus**" scholarship, which has been awarded since 2010.

The «Clinical Medicine Plus» scholarship is aimed at clinically active physicians during or immediately after completing specialist training. The scholarships are intended to finance a training stay at first-class, primarily foreign host institutes and in innovative fields or clinical ancillary sciences. The focus is on gaining knowledge in fields which are given little space in medical studies (e. g. public health, psychosomatic and psychosocial medicine, ethics, IT, epidemiology, pharmacogenetics, forensic medicine, health communication) or on deepening knowledge in special fields / techniques (e. g. specialised clinical techniques, molecular-biochemical methods, computational science). **Pure research projects are not the aim of the programme.**

The candidate must be proposed and supported by a **mentor** from his or her institution in Switzerland, who guarantees the expediency of the training and the quality of the host institution and accompanies the stay as an external tutor. Upon returning home, the mentor shall enable the scholar to be employed. The ‘Clinical Medicine Plus’ scholarship is intended as a contribution to travel expenses and cost of living during the stay at the host institute (3 to max. 12 months).

Period for submission: February 1 – May 31, 2020

Decision by: end of September 2020

Applications must be submitted **by May 31, 2020** to cloetta@stiftung.ch
